### Safeguarding

Safeguarding the children within our care is a high priority which means all our staff are trained appropriately to deal with any issues which may arise. As a childcare setting, we are required to report any safeguarding concerns about the children attending our setting, if we do have a concern regarding a child's welfare, then the local children's services duty officer and Ofsted will be informed.

Within our setting we operate a password and Identification system, in which anyone collecting your child, other than yourselves, can do so with prior confirmation from yourselves and a password. We may also ask for Identification upon pick up.

### SENCO

The setting fulfils the code of practice for the identification of Special Educational Needs (SEN). The child's special educational needs or additional needs must be identified by Parents/Carers, the child's key worker, and any other professional bodies involved with the child e.g., Health Visitor.

We will always consult with the parents and children to discuss what the appropriate next steps will be.

### **Settling in sessions**

Before the children start our setting, we invite them to come and attend three 1-hour sessions, this enables your child to meet the staff and familiarize themselves with this new environment.

These sessions are free of cost.

If a child requires more settling sessions at the nursery, we will discuss with you and arrange further sessions before their start date.

As part of our service, we offer a range of cereals or toast for

breakfast each morning, we also offer a range of different savoury or fruit options for snacks throughout the day.

Water/ Sugar free juice is available throughout the day.

We also offer a cooked evening meal; we follow a monthly menu which is posted on our Facebook page and on the window display at the front of the setting. Should you have any concerns regarding our menu please do not hesitate to contact one of our friendly staff members who will be happy to help.

### **Working In Partnership with Parents**

We can best meet the needs of individual children by working closely with parents and carers. As your child's first carer and educator, you know your child best.

We aim to develop partnerships between parents and carers which are based on mutual trust and respect, and which promote the sharing of information and knowledge for the benefit of the children in my care.

#### Communication

It is extremely important that we communicate effectively. we will keep you informed of daily events and activities, through your child's online daily diary, it will contain information like, what your child has had to eat and drink, nappy changes, sleeps and how they have been in general each day.

We also have a parent Facebook profile which we will use to upload photos of activities all of our children have been doing throughout the day.

We will also let you know about any other important information regarding our childcare service, such as charity days, world book day etc.

### **Key Stages of Development**

As your child grows and develops, issues will crop up that are very important for us to discuss in order that we can work together, and your wishes be incorporated into our care routine for your child. These could include weaning, potting training, managing behaviour, or starting (pre-) school. As these issues arise, we will arrange a suitable time to discuss with you in detail how you would like us to take forward this part of your child's care.

# What to bring to Nursery?

We strongly advise that children are not sent to nursery wearing. their best clothing, although every effort is made to ensure that you child is kept in a respectable state. Children do get extremely messy and can in some cases ruin their clothing.

Teddy Bears Childcare T-shirts/Polo Shirts and Bags can be purchased, should you wish to do so, please contact one of our Nursery staff members who will ensure you are given the link.

## **Terms & Conditions**



Invoicing

Invoices are produced each month based on the days and hours you need for the following month; all invoices are emailed out to parents/carers it is your responsibility to inform us if an invoice has not been received.

Late payment charges will still be applied if payment is not on time, irrespective whether you have received an invoice or not.

### **Payment of Fees**

Fees are required to be paid by the last day of the month.

Invoices will be issues on or around the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.

Any additional payments and extra session charges will be added onto the next invoice.

For late payment of fees, there will be a £20 late payment charge.

For families whose fees are contributed to via the voucher payments (e.g. computer share or Sodexo) it remains your responsibility to ensure that the account has been set-up and processed by your employer, prior to starting the nursery.

For families that are eligible for Tax Free Childcare it remains your responsibility to ensure that the account has been set-up and activated by Government Gateway, prior to starting with the nursery.

The Nursery reserves the right to suspend your child's place where payment is not received.

The nursery reserves the right to increase prices in line with minimum wage increases, you will be notified a month before the price increase takes effect.

### Minimum Booking

Our minimum booking is for at least two half days per week, this is to ensure we can become part of a regular routine for children, and we find the more children attend, the better they tend to settle.

#### Extra Sessions

If parents/ carers require their child to attend the setting for several extra sessions, the nursery will attempt to meet their needs, this is dependent on ratios and staffing. These sessions will be charged at the normal rate.

The nursery may not be able to accept session swaps without 4 weeks' notice and this may only be granted, where possible, dependent on ratios and staffing.



### **Session Changes / Termination of a place**

Teddy Bears Childcare requires one months' notice if you wish to decrease your child sessions or no longer require your child's place.

#### Late collection charges

If children are collected later than the end of their session, a £5 late collection charge will be incurred for every 10 minutes period of lateness. We ask that you please phone the setting as soon as possible to inform us of any anticipated lateness.

Ongoing lateness may be charged at a higher rate.

#### **Payment for Absences**

You will not be charged for the first two weeks of Holiday used; this is subject to four weeks' notice before a holiday. If a child is absent due to illness or injury, you will still be charged for the session and unfortunately missed sessions cannot be swapped.

### **Closures and Opening Times**

Teddy Bears Childcare will be closed on all Bank Holidays and for approximately 2 weeks over the Christmas period, this will include Christmas Eve.

The setting has the right to add extra closures and to amend opening times, but adequate notice will always be given wherever possible.

The Nursery opens at 7am and closes at 5pm, we kindly ask that you do not bring your child until their session time starts, and to ensure that they are collected by 5pm.

### **Personal Property & belongings**

We cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to children's property. But we will ensure we make every reasonable effort to stop children's belongings from being lost or damaged. It is the responsibility of the parents/carers to name and label all personal items.

Thank you for taking the time to read our Nursery Prospectus, whilst we hope that this document provides you with lots of information, our friendly staff team are always at the end of the phone or e-mail should you require any further information.
